



Kreg Allen Brockway

April 4, 1950 - June 2, 2021

Kreg Allen Brockway, 71, of Tulare, California, passed away on Wednesday, June 2, 2021.

Kreg was born on April 4, 1950 to Howard Herbert Brockway and Lerena June Brockway in Santa Maria, California. Kreg served in the Navy from March 1969 until late 1972 and during that time served in the Vietnam War. After his service in the military, Kreg worked in construction for over 3 years before he became a Police Officer.

He continued to serve and protect others by becoming a Police Officer for the Tulare Police Department and Tulare County Sheriff's Department for a combined total of 28 years. During the last 7 years of his service as a Police Officer, Kreg attended National University and Chapman College. He went on to graduate from Cal State Bakersfield and held a total of 3 degrees ♦ a Bachelor's Degree in Police Science, Behavioral Science, and Liberal Studies. He retired from the Tulare Police Department in 2000 and then started teaching later that year. He taught for 20 years at Woodville Elementary in Porterville, California. After retiring from teaching at Woodville Elementary in summer 2020, he immediately began working at Crescent Valley Charter School and taught there until he fell ill in October 2020.

Kreg had many hobbies including fishing, hunting, working out, all water sports, boating, hiking, and gardening. While he had many hobbies, if you knew Kreg ♦ you knew how much he loved his classic cars. He also loved beekeeping with his son, Ty ♦ a hobby they enjoyed doing together.

Kreg and the love of his life Jacqueline "Dannie" married on November 3, 1983. Kreg loved his family so much and especially adored his beautiful wife, Dannie. He is survived by his wife Dannie of thirty-six and half years. His beloved children, Brian Brockway, Brandon Brockway (Chandrena), Ty Brockway (Allison), Kasi Willems (Matt), stepson Chase Hartman, 8 grandchildren, his mother, Lerena June Brockway, his sisters, Kathy Brown (Ken), and Karol Moorman (John), and many nieces and nephews.

Kreg was a generous, kind man with a big heart. He was a hard worker and loved his country, community, and truly served others. He will be greatly missed by his family, friends, and students.

“ My name is Irving Salado Carmeno. Mr. Brockway was my 4th grade teacher and the person that I wanted to be like one day. He helped me in more ways than one, coming from a very poor household that could barely get by- it's something he did for 8 year old me that I'll never forget. It's hard to believe he's not with us anymore.

In 2007-2008 (I don't remember what year exactly) he found out my family didn't celebrate Christmas because we couldn't afford anything besides basic necessities. Mr. Brockway went out of his way to send some friends of his over to the 2 room trailer home I was living in, in the town of woodville, first thing in the morning on Christmas. I still remember exactly what I was given, a Spider-Man glove that shot silly string. They gave my mom extra things like foods and gift cards. I was overjoyed as a child, especially because he knew Spider-Man is my favorite super hero. It's a memory that changed my view of the world forever, I no longer went through life thinking there were only bad people out there. Mr. Brockway was a light in my childhood and became the reason I now study Criminology and Psychology while also aspiring to be a Software Developer in the future. I also entered the field of teaching as an English tutor for young children wanting to learn the language under the TEFL program because he inspired me so much that I wanted to teach too. 4th Grade was a tough time for my family and he knew that personally, so he decided to make it a great year for me and he even remembered my birthday.

I never forgot his talks about never doing drugs, or about his stories as a police officer, or about how proud he was of everyone including me. I moved to Mexico in 2009 and stayed until late 2012, and went through my childhood upholding his teachings in a foreign country for me. Living in a poor state and poor village, I never forgot that people like him existed and he was the kind of person I wanted to be like when I grew up.

I'm 23 today and in the U.S. again, I would've loved to pay him a visit before his passing even though he probably wouldn't remember me.

He was my childhood hero I never forgot about and I know everyone will remember him and miss him dearly.

He was definitely a light in a lot of people's lives and I personally will miss him dearly, and I'll never forget that he treated me like family in a time when I needed a push in the right direction the most. A great father, a great teacher and all around a hero for people like me.
