Freddy Villarreal was born to Pablo and Juanita Villarreal on August 1, 1958 in Bakersfield California and passed away on April 19, 2021 in Visalia California. He was preceded in death by both of his parents, sister Gracie Torrez, brother, Chris "T-Ball" Villarreal and nephew Sergio Villarreal.
