So I brought her on without interviewing her. I then worked with her for 1 year and then we both wanted to transfer out of CWS. We both applied within the county to different department. We both received a letter around the same time that we had gotten approved for our transfers. She had been transferred to mental health and I was transferred back to CCS in Tulare, where I originally started. We spoke about a month later and we were both very happy with our current jobs. She had invited me to her church about 2 years ago and introduced me to her husband and son. They were both gentlemen's. She always bragged about them. This was her calling and it was a little to soon, but she is that beautiful angel in heaven now looking down on us smiling. One thing that sticks out about Bea when introducing her to someone is; "she wiggles her eye brows when she laughs." I will miss you Bea! I can't imagine what her husband and son are going through right now. Bea was a beautiful person on the inside and the outside. I will be praying for her family. God bless.
