



## Beverly Ann Goodyear

February 25, 1942 - June 29, 2023

Beverly Ann Goodyear, 81, died unexpectedly June 29, 2023, at Kaweah Delta Hospital in Visalia. She was born February 25, 1942 in Omaha Nebraska and grew up in Herman, the daughter of Kenneth William Kubie and Burnice (Himeline) Kubie.

Beverly graduated from North High School in Omaha Nebraska, followed by a BA from University of Nebraska and two Master's Degrees from Fresno State. Beverly married Don Goodyear in Colorado and they celebrated 50 years together in August 2022. Beverly spent most of her career dedicated to working with Child Protective Services and Central Valley Regional Center. In retirement Beverly was also owner of When Pigs Fly antique store in Exeter, CA for over 15 years.
