On January 23rd, 2023, at the age of 71 Daniel Joseph Perry of Tulare County went to be with Jesus. He was known by most as Danny. He was a beloved Son, Brother, Brother-in-law, Cousin, Uncle, Husband, Father, Father-in-law and Grandfather. Danny was born in 1951 in Tulare County California to Daniel and Frances Perry his loving parents. He was the middle child out of 3 children. He was blessed to also grow up with a cousin whom he called his brother. Danny graduated from Tulare Union High School in 1970. After high school he served in the United States Army for 2 years. Danny then went on to College of the Sequoias and trade schools to obtain certificates in automotive body repair. He worked as a body and fender repairman for 33 years until retiring. For many years after retiring Danny fought through stage 4 kidney disease, cancer and other health problems ultimately losing the battle and passing peacefully with family at his side.

He won fishing competitions and had numerous fish mounted, one of which is a state record and put on display at Sierra Sporting Goods in Exeter CA as well in his home. Danny was preceded in death by his parents Daniel and Frances. He is survived by his wife Gayle; His four children: Kimberly, James, Ryan, and Lynae; His sons-in-law: Matt and Mikey; His 11 grandchildren: Miranda, Dylan,
