



## Donna Rengh

December 12, 1952 - June 27, 2018

After a life of dedication and service to the community, on Wednesday, June 27, 2018, Donna Lynn Rengh (nee Gore) passed away at home at the age of 65. She was predeceased by her parents, Harold and Genevieve Gore, and her older brother Willie. Donna is survived and lovingly remembered by her sister-in-law Jeanne, nephew Matthew (Danielle), and niece Meganne (Jeremy), as well as Matthew's daughters Kana, Melynda, and Leelu.

Born in Sanger, CA in 1952 Donna graduated from Sanger High School before earning a degree in microbiology from Fresno State in 1974.
