Dorotha Chrystell Arterbury was born April 27, 1921 to George and Mytle Arterbury in Duncan, Oklahoma. She was baptized at 13 years old. Her family moved to Visalia from Oklahoma about 1935.

Dorotha married Marvin Glasgow (age 20) when she was 18 years old on April 1, 1940. Marvin and Chris (as her family called her) she inherited 41plus acres and a dairy from Marvin father, Harry Glasgow about 1945. They soon switched to cotton farming.
