Enedina Rojas Esquivel was born on May 14, 1936 in San Luis Potosi, Mexico. She passed away peacefully with her family at her side in Visalia. She was devoted to her husband of 71 years and her family her entire life. Enedina migrated to the United States at the age of 10. She married and lived in Texas before settling in California in 1958.

Enedina had little formal education in Mexico. Throughout her marriage she occasionally worked in the fields with her husband. She started full time work after the birth of her sixth child, at the Tulare County Head Start Center, Woodville Farm Labor Camp. Enedina worked hard and dedicated herself to complete classes for a Childrens Center Instruction Permit. She was eventually promoted to Head Start Teacher. Enedina loved working with "her children" throughout her 32 years at the Center. She finally retired in 2001.

Enedina was an important part of a community group working alongside her husband, to raise funds and finally construct a Catholic church in the small community of Woodville where she lived for many years prior to moving to Visalia.

She is preceded in death by her parents, a younger sister and her beloved granddaughter Monique Martinez.

Enedina is survived by her husband, Jose Guillermo Esquivel; three siblings, Juan, Pepe and Juanita; six children, Guillermo, Jr. (Virginia); Gloria (Alfonso); Michael; Elva (Byron); Jesus (Patricia); and Hilda (Charlie); ten grandchildren, Omar, Marcel, Stephanie, Christina, Justin, Madeline, Miranda, Jacob, Mathew, Corina and Isaac; nine great grandchildren who knew her as "Nana", Adrian, Ulysses, Olivia, Xiomara, Aviva, Tizoc, Silas, Marcos and Amaya.

Enedina was a loving, compassionate woman of faith who enjoyed gardening, family activities and attending church. She will be greatly missed by her family and friends.
