Gorman Seal passed away on Thursday, May 6th 2021 at Kaweah Delta Hospital at the age of 80. Gorman has been a long-time resident of Tulare County for 60+ years.

Gorman was born in Mansfield, Missouri on October 26 1940. He married Pat Pendleton on June 11th, 1959 in Exeter California where they had two daughters Barbara (BJ) and Karen.
