Harriet was born in Mandan, North Dakota to Stephen and Esther Kidd, the youngest of five children. She was raised there, met her husband Allen Widger and married in 1940. Allen enlisted in 1942 and served 2 1/2 years in the Pacific Theater during WWII while Harriet waited for him at home. Upon his return, they moved to South Gate, Ca where Allen started his 25 year career as a truck driver for Safeway stores and Harriet went to work at Bank of America as a teller in 1961. They stayed in the Southern California area until moving to Twin Falls, Idaho in 1984 upon Allen's retirement.

Unfortunately, he passed away on January 17, 1986 after a short and unexpected health issue. Harriet then decided to move to Visalia to be near her brother Steve, his wife Esther and their Kidd family. She was a joy to add to the family dynamic and we treasure the 32 years we had with her.

Harriet was predeceased also by her parents, siblings, three nephews, and her dear friends Alice, Crystal and Donna. She is survived by sister in law Esther Klidd, nephew Don (Barbara) Kidd of Visalia, nieces Carol(Jim) Scales of Fresno, Linda, Nancy, Barbara, and Elaine and many grand nieces and nephews.
