Jack "Bucky" McPhetridge, 81, went to be with the Lord on May 5, 2026. He was born on November 5, 1944, to Pete and Joyce McPhetridge.

While he could be tough and hot-headed at times, especially in his younger years, anyone who knew Bucky knew he had a big heart and would do anything for someone in need.

More than anything, Bucky loved the Lord and loved his family. His faith guided the way he lived his life, and his family finds comfort knowing he is now at peace in the presence of his Savior.
