Jane Schuyler Hornung was born in Whittier, CA on February 16, 1929, to parents Harry A. and Edith (Owen) Schuyler and passed away at the age of 93 on November 26, 2022, at Quail Park Memory Care, Visalia, CA.

Jane grew up on the Leffingwell Ranch (lemon orchards) in Whittier, CA. After graduating from Stanford University, she married Byron A. Hornung in 1952 and they were blessed with three children; Stacy Ann, Craig, and Charles.

Jane was devoted to her family, agriculture and service to her community.
