As a student at COS he worked to help pay his way at the school and on the weekends he worked in the fields picking tomatoes where he met his wife. His wife's best friend from childhood asked her if she wanted to work in the field in the summer and she said sure. So this is how God had Joe and Nancy meet. Joe and Nancy married on February 28,

1976 in Las Vegas. They were married 40 years. They have 2 sons, Joseph and Richard. Some of their favorite vacations were camping, visiting museums in San Francisco, LA and San Diego. Their sons played sports and they recorded every game rain or shine so they could critic themselves. His life was fulfilled when he started getting grandchildren. He loved them with all his heart.
