Joseph Delgadillo Reynoso "Joe" was born on August 8th, 1942 in La Habra California to Francisco Vicuna Reynoso and Josefa Delgadillo Reynoso. The family later moved to Visalia where Joe assisted his parents in the fields where they would pick produce. This is also where Joe met his future wife Connie S. Garcia. Joe graduated from Mt. Whitney High School in 1960, was very involved in sports such as baseball, and basketball. Following High School, Joe attended College of the Sequoias.

Joe married Connie on May 9th, 1964 and had four children. He then went into the Army and the National Guard and was deployed to Watts during the riots in 1965. Joe was a staff Sergeant and received a Commendation Pendant and Ribbon. Following his service, Joe worked for Southern California Edison Company and became a journeyman, where he was employed for 35 years until he retired. .

Joe's passions included baseball, horses, and being involved in the National Federation de Charros where he was president for The Association de Charros de Visalia, Los Gavilanes where they would teach youth and young men the care of horses and instruct them in the art of riding, roping, and rodeo events.

Joe continued his passion with baseball as he coached his sons baseball team, The Pirates for Visalia Little League. He continued to coach for 25 years. In addition to his sons, Joe also coached many of his nephews, neighborhood kids and even his grandkids later in life.

Joe was a dedicated husband, father, grandfather and friend. He was preceded in the afterlife by his parents, Francisco and Josefa Reynoso; three sisters, Lilly Villalobos, Clemencia (Menchi) Haro, Linda Jasso, and three brothers Lalo Reynoso, Celso Reynoso, and Frank Reynoso, his in-laws, Pedro Garcia and Marcella S.
