Visalia - Lee M. Miner, 87, died Friday, May 25, 2018 at Westgate Gardens Care Center in Visalia following a long illness.

She was predeceased by her husband of 59 years, R. David Miner, her sisters Ilene, Esther, and Ethel, her brother, George and leaves nieces and nephews in Arizona, California, Illinois, Indiana, and Missouri and many close friends. She is the daughter of Ada Lee and James William Moore.

Lee was a member of the singing group, The Woodlandaires in the 1960's and participated in one of Bob Hopes' Far East tours, entertaining our Vietnam troops. Her other interests included writing the book, Encyclopedia of Cooking and teaching cooking classes. She was a devoted resident of Visalia and was an active member of the Newcomers Club and the Symphony League where she served as President, wrote the Symphony Newsletter, sold wine at Symphony events to raise funds. She and Dave volunteered at Traver Elementary school where Lee again participated in several fundraising activities.
