



## Lino Esquio Moran

November 18, 1939 - January 30, 2020

Lino Moran was born November 18, 1939 in Tulare, CA and passed away peacefully on January 30, 2020.

Lino was preceded in death by his parents; Fidel Moran and Benigna Beltran, brothers; Manuel Moran and Ralph Moran, sisters; Jessie Perez and Lucy Moran. Lino is survived by Linda, his wife of 59 years, four daughters; Valorie Aguilera (Antonio), Laurie Villegas (Guadalupe), Shirley Moran, and Debra Sanchez (Guadalupe) and son; Larry Moran. He was loved by his 8 grandchildren and 14 great grandchildren.

Lino became involved with the Tulare Co Civil Grand Jury in 2004, served as foreman for one term and continued his service until 2018. Lino studied and graduated from C.O.S. and earned an AA degree in LVN Nursing, setting the path for male nurses. Lino served as president of the Woodlake Valley Chamber of Commerce which established the first Woodlake City Queen. Lino was very active in his community by serving as chief polling officer in Woodlake for election years. Well known as Mr. Lino by the YMCA kids he mentored and frequently attended City Council meetings. In 2013, Lino was voted by his community peers and was awarded Woodlake's Lifetime Achievement Award.

Lino's passion for life was his love for jogging, inspired by his brothers. As a

fundraiser, while he worked at Mervyn's, Lino would run from his hometown of Woodlake to Mervyn's Department Store in Visalia, a total of 25 miles. It became known as "Pops Run." Speaking of Pops, Lino coached softball teams; Pops Gang (Co-Ed) in 1996, then Pops Girls in 1998.

Lino will be missed dearly by all. Lino's legacy will continue to thrive through his family and friends.
