Logan James Heath went to be with the Lord on December 14, 2022. He passed peacefully in his home in Woodlake, California. Logan was born on April 9, 1927, to Logan James and Elizabeth Heath (Neil) in Phoenix, Arizona. Raised in Phoenix, he attended Madison School and North Phoenix High School graduating in 1946. His junior and senior year he competed on the track team and was in the ROTC club where he served as an officer both years. Following high school, he enlisted in the Coast Guard to serve his country in World War II. Following his time in the service, he attended Phoenix College where he earned his BS in Engineering and Business. Logan then moved to California where he worked for Jorgenson Steel, Reliance Steel and Drake Steel. Later he started B&H Trenching where he laid the first cable for television in California. In the early seventies, Logan moved to Visalia where he brought Ditch Witch to the Central Valley. Logan enjoyed serving the Lord and one of his favorite ways to serve was building churches with his friends in California and in Mexico. Logan loved to fly more than he loved to eat. One of his ventures was flying guests to Bear Lake Lodge in Alaska for his friend Don Johnson. Logan loved his country. One his favorite memories was being selected and attending the 2018 Honor Flight with the Central Valley Honor Flight group. He was a Mason and a member of the Tulare County Sheriff's Posse. Logan was preceded in death by his father, mother and his only brother, Lynn. Logan loved his family, and he will be truly missed. He leaves behind his wife Janey who lovingly cared for him at home. He also leaves

behind three daughters, Karen Heath, Shannon O'Dell (husband Don), Maureen LeDesma, also, three stepdaughters, Nancy Stidman (husband Ben), Melinda (husband John), and Lezlie Blair.
