During World War II they moved with their two sons, Jim and Tom, to Portland, Oregon for Marvin to work in the shipyards. In 1952 they moved to Los Angeles, California where Marvin worked as a sheet metal worker. In 1981, they moved to Woodlake, California. Teava passed away in 2000, and in 2001 he married a family friend, Erma Haddock.

He loved to fish, in lakes and also deep-sea fishing, and spent time fishing with children and grandchildren, and he almost always had a fishing boat and enjoyed restoring old campers.

On December 7th, 1941, Marvin gave his life to Jesus Christ, and served Him faithfully for the rest of his life. He was an active member of the Apostolic Faith Church, and raised his children and grandchildren to know Jesus.
