Mynervia "Inez" Fine, passed away peacefully on Monday, December 28, 2020 at the age of 97 years old

Mom was born to Thomas Columbus Hunt and Alice Lovetta Nance-Hunt, on March 13, 1923 in Okehma in Okfuskee County, Oklahoma. Mom was the youngest of eight children. There were four sisters ~ Hester Orlena "Lena"; Gladys Delora "Gladys" or "Joe"; Tressie Pauline "Pauline"; Elmina Lovetta "Aunt Pee Wee" and three brothers ~ Coy Hunt (killed in World War II); Willie "Athel" (a WWII vet) and "Thomas Floyd" (a WWII vet).
