Nick loved where God had put him, including his full time studies in Accounting at Calvin University, his full time job at Pet Supplies Plus, his Van Auken housemates, and the many critters that came into his life on a frequent basis. Nick had many gifts and talents and loved his family and friends to the fullest. When contemplating the sudden passing of Nick, our hope turns to God's Word and Q&A 1 of the Heidelberg Catechism: "What is your only comfort in life and death? That I am not my own, but belong with body and soul, both in life and in death, to my faithful Savior Jesus Christ. He has fully paid for all my sins with his precious blood, and has set me free from all the power of the devil.
