Norman James Boyles lost his battle to cancer on January 17, 2023. Norman was born in Mechanicsville, Iowa on March 2, 1939. He married the love of his life, Barbara Jean October 15, 1961.

Norman Boyles was enlisted in the Navy in March 1958 where he was assigned to NAS Lemoore in 1961. He moved his family to California where he resided since. Norman retired from the Navy in March 1978 with many military awards, achievements, and metals. Once he retired from the Navy, he did Twenty-Two years of civil service (MWR).

Norman loved to golf and worked at the Kings Country Club for many years thereafter. He was a member of the Fleet Reserve Association since 1978 and Veteran Foreign War where he served as Commander.
