On May 23, 2014, Norman Eugene Wieland was called home by his Lord and Savior at the age of 83. Born August 10, 1930 to Louis and Cora Wieland in Princeville, IL. After graduating from Princeville High School, he joined the Navy. While in the Navy, Norm was a Yeoman on a munitions ship in the Pacific during the Korean Conflict, visiting Japan and other ports.
