Robert Carl (Bob) Weinberger passed away suddenly at home of natural causes on November 5th 2014 in Visalia.

Robert Carl Weinberger was born on his family's' farm October 27, 1927 in Dinuba CA to Mary and Karl Weinberger. He was the sixth of six children. He attended Dinuba High School and graduated in June 1945 after which he enlisted in the United States Navy. He was sent to the Philippines as part of the Allied occupation. When WWII ended in 1946 he was honorably discharged from the Navy. He returned home, where he met Virginia Mae Lowry at a dance in Visalia. They were married March 26, 1949.

Bob was a life long farmer and began his agricultural career working on his parents' farm where they grew grapes. Bob and Virginia purchased their own farm southeast of Dinuba growing grapes and annual crops and raising their two sons. Over time he managed other farms. He finished his career on a 120 acre wine grape farm near Tulare CA.

He had a passion for growing things. His hobby was vegetable gardening and he was known for his large and delicious tomatoes. He also loved fishing and later in his life he would enjoy fishing trips with his son Gary and grandson Kevin.

He felt his greatest achievement and pride were his sons, grandchildren and great grandchildren.

He is survived by his wife Virginia, sister Dorothy and sons, Marc and Gary. Six grandchildren, Nick, Chris, Brian, Kevin, Joshua and Emily. Four great-grandchildren, Daniel, Andrew, Caelyn and Aubriegh.
