



Robert A. Williams

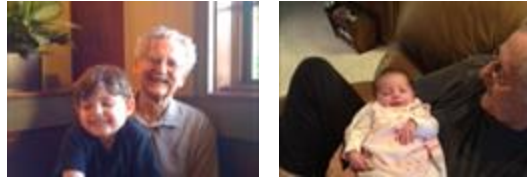
June 16, 1928 - February 5, 2017
