Long time Lindsay resident Ruby "Jean" Hill, beloved wife, mother, grandmother, and friend, passed away peacefully on November 29, 2023 at the age of 93. Jean was born on November 5, 1930 in Boulder City, Missouri to Clifford and Minnie Nelson and attended local schools and business college.
