Aside from this though she was the ultimate giver of love for all kids that were part of the neighborhood and school teams that her kids were a part of.

The family from Iceland became close friends and had visited Visalia several times as well as George and Sandra traveling to Iceland.

They loved going on cruises and on one met Lou and Carol, who became lifelong friends from Chicago. Each year they would either be in Chicago or hosting Lou and Carol in Visalia. Ron and Joyce were their lifelong friends from high school. They would travel, go to dances, and even do remodeling together.
