On the eve of July 4th 2015 Sarah passed away at UCSF Medical Center surrounded by family. Sarah was 36 years old.

Sarah was born in West Covina, Ca. on August 31st 1978.

As a young child growing up Sarah was a "tomboy" of sorts, opting to wear baseball caps instead of ribbons and berets. Jeans and tee shirts in lieu of skirts and blouses and "pretty dresses". Sarah gradually evolved from her baseball cap and jeans to a young lady and then on to becoming a loving mother.

Sarah lived most of her childhood in Woodlake, Ca. before moving to Kern County. She graduated jr. and high schools in Kern county then went on to attend Golden State Business College. She was employed at Kern County Child Support Division before making the decision to leave her position to care for her ailing husband and father of her four children. Sarah cared for her husband Jesse till his death on June 25th 2014.
