



Terry Craig Pannell

November 27, 1946 - September 20, 2023

Terry Craig Pannell died on September 20, 2023 in Visalia and is now in the arms of our Lord. Terry was born on November 27, 1946 to Margaret (Jo) and Robert Pannell in Woodlake. He graduated from Mt. Whitney High School in 1964 and joined the US Air Force in May of 1965 and was stationed at Lackland AFB in San Antonio, Texas. He was a Morse Interceptor Operator and served in Cambodia and Laos. Upon discharge he was an E-4 Sergeant. Terry had an adventurous spirit and spent many years living in different countries including Thailand, Colombia, Ecuador and Mexico. Upon his return to the states he made Fresno his home. Terry often traveled to Miami when able.

Terry was a member of the West Coast Believers Center International Church (WCBCI) in Visalia. He attended church regularly until he contracted Covid 19 in October of 2020. Post Covid he observed services online at his home.

Terry is survived by four sons, Sterling Pannell of Fresno, Jordan Pannell (Sally) of Clovis, Anthony (Paige) Pannell of Layton, Utah, and Michael Pannell of Miami Florida; 5 grandchildren, Akira Pannell, Nathaniel Pannell, Ayden Pannell, Meredith Pannell and Walker Pannell; a sister, Sharon How-Cochran (Larry) of Visalia and a nephew, Eric How of Pflugerville, Texas.
