Thomas Earl Beach, 75, gained his angel wings and left us to be with the lord on July 12, 2023, in Tulare, California, surrounded by family. Tom was born the youngest of twelve children to Robert J. and Margaret G. (Mahon) Beach on February 14, 1948, in Watertown, New York.

At 16, Tom met the love of his life Beverly Kalk at a High School dance, who just a couple of years later would become his beloved spouse of 55 years. They married on April 7, 1966, and lived in Watertown, NY, until 1974, when they moved to California, where they raised their three kids, Tammy, Sherry, and Thomas.

Tom was a welder for 40 years working for local shops at the beginning of his career, and eventually opened and operated Tom Beach's Portable Welding. During his lifetime, Tom enjoyed camping at the coast, trips back home to Watertown, NY, to visit family, hunting, fishing, collecting antiques, restoring old cars, playing cards, playing the spoons, and dancing to good old rock and roll music.
