



Vukosava Krstic

December 29, 1936 - April 23, 2016

Vukosava (Vicky) Krstic was born near Banja Luka, Bosnia – Herzegovina on December 29, 1936 and passed peacefully in Visalia, CA on April 23, 2016. Vicky was one of eight siblings born to Risto and Vasilija Janjic. She immigrated to the United States with her husband, Dusan Krstic, and their daughter, Marija, living in Palo Alto, CA for several years before moving to Visalia, CA in 1969, where she lived until her passing. Vicky was preceded in death by her mother, Vasilija, and father, Risto; her brothers Bosko, Zdravko and Mladen; and sisters Ljubica and Radojka.
