Whitney (the highest point in the United States) which he accomplished at the age of 50.

Wes loved his Lord and Savior which led to many mission trips to Bogota, Honduras, Belize, Nome, Alaska and others in the United States. Wes built props for Vacation Bible School and helped at Grace Community Church on Wednesdays for many years.
