“ Please forgive my meekness as I compose this memory... Mr. Rouse, neither I, nor my wife, did not know you physically on this earth, however, we did know your spirit... The love of the road, the mountains, the wind: nothing could ever compare to the freedom we felt on two wheels. Solo, Passenger, or Stagger, it was as if angels were riding along side us, joining us as we all threw our left arms down as we passed by each other, truly wishing we could "low-five" without causing any damage to ourselves, or our chariots. The reason I write to you today is so that you and all who read this message may know that those very same roads are the roads my wife and I traveled when we were dating. I will never forget the feeling of her arms around me as we leaned through the turns of Highway180's gorgeous views. With tears streaming down our faces, I closed your eyelids, I placed my hand on your heart, gripped your hand and prayed that your soul had already found rest, and your spirit also was resting with those in your family whom had gone home before you.

As a lover of the road, mountains, motorcycles, and the ever growing fraternity of motorcyclists, may I share this desperate cry to all who may read these words on behalf of Mr. Rouse: It is not about the way YOU ride, it's about the way the OTHERS' drive/ride. The ones who have been safely riding for the longest time are the ones who are taken away so quickly. Please, to all who brave the roads, Godspeed. May the Lord Jesus Christ ride alongside you, staggered by legions of His Strongest angels, protecting you all.

To you Mr. Rouse, I only wish to have known you here on this earth. Maybe we rode together unknowingly, or dropped our left arms towards one another as we passed by each other, but regardless: I hope to meet you in Heaven, and have the chance to shake your hand, and talk motorcycles with you.

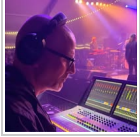
